**ASSISTANT SECRETARY ROBERT BARHAM HONORED
BY CCA LOUISIANA**

Office of State Parks Assistant Secretary Robert Barham was honored February 26, 2016, with the CCA Louisiana Board of Directors Award at the organization's opening conference banquet in Baton Rouge. This award is a rare honor given by CCA and recognizes individuals with extraordinary service to Louisiana. Lt. Governor Billy Nungesser, who recently appointed Barham to the position of Assistant Secretary, was on hand to address CCA Louisiana members as the keynote speaker.

Barham's recognition covered his activities during his tenure as the Secretary of the Louisiana Department of Wildlife & Fisheries. Camp Mattens, member of the Gulf States Marine Fisheries Council and 2016 CCA Louisiana Hall of Fame Inductee, cited the accomplishments by the Department of Wildlife & Fisheries under Barham's leadership, including a prolific artificial reef program, the creation of the marine fish tagging and creel programs, advocating the management of several fish species, and his effort during the aftermath of the Gulf Oil Disaster in 2010.

In his introduction to Barham, Mattens said that Barham "...was recognized by his peers and by stakeholder groups from all sectors as a visionary leader and an outstanding guardian of Louisiana's fish and wildlife resources."
