Antonio Phelipe Marigny, a resident of this City and coheir of one third of the maternal estate of his half-brother the late Ignacio Broutin as evidenced by the documents he presented, petitioned the Court to make a partition of the maternal estate of said deceased so that he may secure his share. He also petitioned the Court that the wife of the deceased Broutin be questioned in accordance with the interrogatory he presented. The Court granted the petition and Juan Maria Marta Chauvin, widow of the deceased and at present wife of Agustin Macarty, answered the first question of the interrogatory declaring that her husband, through Francisco Maria de Reggio, his agent in this city, gave her the sum of 2000 pesos in view of the marriage ("arras propter nupcias") and that for her dower and preciput she did not receive anything from the deceased Broutin. To the second question she answered that since Broutin departed from this City he did not send her any money; that when he died in Paris, his agent took possession of his estate consisting of jewelry and letters of exchange and that despite her requests to the agent for an account of the estate she was unable to obtain it. To the third question she answered that when Broutin went to France he left her a negro slave named Joseph which she kept to defray some expenses she made when Broutin died.

The record shows that sometime later Antonio Phelipe Marigny filed suit against Francisco Maria de

Reggio and his wife to recover the sum of 7000 pesos plus 5% interest in which they were indebted to the succession of the deceased Broutin as evidenced by the obligation presented by Reggio. The Court decided in favor of Marigny, however, Reggio failed to pay and Marigny again petitioned the Court to issue a writ of execution against the person and properties of Reggio to satisfy the sum claimed plus interest and costs of the proceedings.

Marigny died and the action instituted by him against Reggio was continued by his heirs Pedro Marigny and Carlos Onorato Olivier (son and son-in-law of the deceased Marigny)

The decision rendered by the court in favor of the deceased Marigny was protested by Reggio and he appealed the case to the Superior Court in Havana. All the documents pertaining to these proceedings were ready to be sent to Havana for the final decision when the case was dismissed on petition of Pedro Marigny and Olivier who declared that they realized their action was groundless; they also agreed to pay the cost of the proceedings.
